Together, the trinkets can be used to inspire storytelling or test memory, logic and more.

Each "Think-ets" drawstring pouch comes with a collection of 15 trinkets from all over the world.

The trinkets have been selected from 10 sources in eight countries, including Germany, India, Africa and the United States. The company draws from more than 150 unique trinkets so no two sets are alike.
