Think-Ets is a bag with miniature toys and instructions with ideas for 10 games you can play with them. Kids will come up with their own ideas for playing with the miniatures. Although there may be some overlap, no two bags are ever the same but some examples of miniatures are trees, tools or animals.

The **Think-Ets** are pegged as being great for at home, travel, camping and parties but here's where they got me- restaurants. Sold! I can't tell you how many times I've played "which hand is it in?" with a pack of Sweet-n-Low to entertain my kids while we waited for food. These are good for restaurants. They don't make noise or take up very much space and more than one child can play.

Think-Ets are showing up in specialty toy shops and are also available on line at www.think-a-lot.com for around \$9.00.

These are miniatures so they are **not for kids three and under**. The games are geared towards kids 8 & up but younger kids do enjoy them too.
